At Valley View we shared the Gospel more than a half dozen times. We were also encouraged to speak with a number of believers who encouraged us in our ministry. One believer was a little hesitant to answer me when I

asked her if she knew how to get to heaven. She at first said no, then asked me if I knew. I told her the way to heaven was through faith in Jesus Christ. She then said she believed that as well. She told me that she wondered if I was a lunatic when I asked her this question. We had a nice conversation afterwards and she encouraged us in our witnessing efforts. I have been reminded that people in Jesus' day thought he was a lunatic too! Craig had the opportunity to share a number of tracts with teenagers when he took his sons to the Monster Truck show. At the train station in Fort Worth I spoke with several homeless men. One man, Dwayne, was stranded in Fort Worth after having his ID stolen. I contributed to his bus fare and then asked if I could pray for him. It was amazing to see God work on this burly man as he broke down and cried and then prayed with me to be delivered from his addictions and rededicate his life to Christ!
