***Standing for the Constitution***

I saw on the news today that a Nebraska senator has filed a lawsuit against God. Can God win a lawsuit? Let me tell share a personal example. On April 2<sup>nd</sup> I was out witnessing at Arbor Hills nature preserve with three other men. One of the patrons of the park was offended by our presence and called the police. The police said that if we continued to distribute tracts (literature) that they would have us arrested. We ceased our activities for that night and have not been able to witness in the parks in Plano since then. Believing that we had a clear civil rights issue we sought legal advice from American Liberties Institute

(ALI) which provides free legal services to Evangelists. We worked with ALI and local counsel at Liberty Legal Institute over the past several months. On August 31, a case was filed in Federal court in Sherman against the City of Plano. Rather than serve the city, the attorney's sent a letter notifying the city attorney of the case. The city attorney called a special session of the City Council who met Friday night and voted to amend the park policy. Tonight I returned to Arbor Hills to witness. It is nice to have our "fishing hole" back. God wins! An article describing this made the front page of the Plano Star Courier on Saturday.
