This was an exciting week for Bezeugen. Friday at lunch time, Craig and I witnessed to a number of people at Valley View mall. We had the opportunity to continue a dialog with one of the kiosk workers. Friday night Brad and I were witnessing at Stonebriar Mall. We spoke with a number of Israeli Jews and shared the reason for the season with other mall goers. On Sunday, Todd, Jimmy and I distributed over 800 Christmas Quiz tracts before the Cowboys game. We had a number of good opportunities to share one on one with people as well. On Saturday morning, Kelly and I headed to Operation Christmas Gift at the Dallas convention center. Kelly volunteered with the pray ministry. I served on the evangelism team. Operation Christmas Gift is the nations largest Christmas Party for the homeless. Post-event statistics indicate that nearly 8000 people were ministered too. It was cold, windy and

rainy. Not ideal conditions to be outside. But, while sharing the Gospel, the foul weather was hardly noticeable. I had the



opportunity to share the gospel a number of times as I helped the people fill out the required form to get into the convention center where they would receive medical care, hair cuts, blankets, shoes, jackets and a Christmas gift. While working outside I spoke with Diangelo. As I walked him thought the gospel he got big tears in his eyes. I asked him if he wanted to accept Christ. He said "Yes!". What a privilege it was to be there when he placed his trust in our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. I will remember this always. But it was not the most impacting thing that I witnessed that day. I noticed a man-

in a t-shirt with only socks on his feet. I said "when you get inside they will give you some new shoes". His reply to me was "I have Jesus in my heart. I don't need shoes. Jesus is all I need.." It turns out he had just given his jacket to the man next to him. He explained to me that that mans jacket was wet and therefore needed it more than he did. I was overcome by this mans generosity.
