## Funerals

*"Go therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son, and the Holy Spirit..." Matthew 28:19*

Ten out of ten people die. The last week and a half has been a constant reminder of that. First, a neighbor of my mom's and father of my sisters long time friend from high school died in Norman, OK. His funeral was last Saturday. He was a long time believer in Christ. Then, last Thursday night we received word that Marshall Byrd had passed away. Marshall is the husband of my mom's friend Elenore whom she went to nursing school with. Marshall had been suffering from ALS for many years. I had the pleasure of meeting him and Elenore when I was in California last fall. Although Marshall only had slight movement in one eye he could communicate by blinking and smiling. He acknowledged that he wanted me to pray with him before I left his house that night. After praying with him he looked at peace. Monday night my grandfather passed away. He was 97. When I saw him in September he was hardly able to talk because of recovering from a stroke. However, when I asked him if he believed in Jesus for his salvation he said "Oh, Yes". Those two words and the "I love you" before I left were the clearest words I heard him say

when I was there. So what do these three men have in common? Their faith has saved them. Today they

are all in Heaven with our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ! Ultimately this is why we do what we do with evangelism. Everyone will die and face their creator. We want them to be prepared for that meeting by knowing that Jesus is the only way to heaven. There is no bearing on what we do in our lives; only whether we have believed in Jesus.

Now compare these men of God with Aubrey whom I spoke with on the street last week in Hot Springs. I introduced myself to Aubrey when I saw

him light up a cigarette on the street corner. I went up to him and said "I'm sorry sir, you can't smoke here, I will have to give you this ticket". Then I handed him a Ticket to Heaven tract! He was not sure what I was talking about at first, but I got into a good conversation with him about heaven and hell, the ten commandments and Jesus. Aubrey was visiting from California. He does not believe in God. He believes we are living in hell already and that it can't be any worse after he dies. Eventually his sister Sandra joined the conversation. At first she claimed to be a Christian, but then agreed with her brother that this (life on earth) is hell. She finally asked me "how do you save a satanist, like him?". I said that I could not save him; only God can do that. I went on to tell them what the Bible says hell is like. I asked them to consider what if they are wrong about eternity and to consider what we talked about. They agreed and we parted company. I can't imagine not being concerned about going to hell.
