Why do we do what we do?

"Go therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son, and the Holy Spirit..." Matthew 28:19

Todd and I were witnessing on Wednesday night at The Shops at Legacy in Plano. We were talking with a fellow believer who asked us "why do you do what you are doing?" I told him that as I have realized how many people are lost and going to hell, that I feel compelled to go out and talk to people about the Gospel and share the message of salvation with anyone who will listen. From reading Matthew 7 it appears there are more people going to hell (many entering the wide gate) then to heaven (few entering the narrow gate). As I thought about and prayed about this more I came across these verses in Romans 10:13-15:

"Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? And how can they preach unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!"



How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace, who bring good tidings, who proclaim salvation, who say to Zion, "Your God reigns!" -Isaiah 52:7

People are saved by believing in the name of the Lord: Jesus! In order to believe they must hear the message. We are God's seed sowers!

Fort Worth Main Street Art Festival

Last Saturday we went to the Fort Worth Main Street Art Festival. We handed out about 400 Gospel tracts and had a number of excellent conversations with people. The Gospel was shared! One thing that is interesting to do is notice peoples t-shirts. Then engage them in conversation using their shirt as a discussion starter. For instance one guy had a shirt

that said "Smile, Jesus Loves You!" I had a nice conversation with him. He was a very strong believer and was able to share with us how to be saved. Along with that shirt we also saw shirts that said "Have a nice day" with a picture of satan in the middle (he declined to talk to me) and one that said "Kill Yourself - all the cool kids are doing it". His claim was he wears this shirt to offend people like me. Actually, I was not offended. It just makes me sad that someone would waste their money on such a shirt. Another interesting dialog was with an ex-Catholic who still believes much of that churches teaching including that his good is going to out weigh his bad on judgement day. I explained to him that he could only be saved by faith and not by his own works (Eph 2:8-10). Not getting any where I was about to excuse myself. He told me it was good that I was doing what I was doing because there were a lot of lost people there. I looked at him, right in the eye, and said "I know what you mean."
