"Go therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son, and the Holy Spirit..." Matthew 28:19

What is going on in America? California is just weeks away from allowing gay marriage. New York's governor has said the state will recognize these marriages. In Detroit a high school coach was let go because his assistant tried to witness to Muslim students even though it took place outside of the school or any school sanctioned event. In Texas, numerous Hindu and Buddhist Temples are being constructed. Paul reminds us in Romans 1:25, "They exchanged the truth of God for a lie and worshipped and served created things rather than the Creator who is forever praised." On Wednesday night Todd and I witnessed to two Muslims. We had a great conversation with them and they were open to taking our tracts and a Gospel of John and said they would read it. On Thursday I saw on the news that in Iran we would face the death penalty for even trying to talk to them about Jesus and they would too if they convert to Christianity. When I shared the Gospel with a family member recently I was told that I "need to be tolerant of people's beliefs". As a good friend of mine put it, I am not willing to tolerate letting satan lead all these people to hell and stand idly by and do nothing.

All of these things show me all the more need for us to take Jesus' command to make disciples all the more seriously. It is my prayer that the church will wake up, share the Gospel and live as a witness for Christ for America and the world to see.
