# What is a Christian?

"Go therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son, and the Holy Spirit..." Matthew 28:19

Often times when we are out witnessing to people they will identify themselves as Christian. The term is often over used and mis-used. I get to the point where I think people think they are Christian because they go to church. That is like saying that if I stand in my garage that I am a car. I came across some quotes in an interview recently that I would like to take a look at here. The interviewee starts out stating, "I am a Christian." Okay, so if we take this person at their word we would think they are saved. However, he goes on to say, "I'm rooted in the Christian tradition. I believe that there are many paths to the same place, and that is a belief that there is a higher power, a belief that we are connected as a people." Huh? How can this be? In John 14:67, Jesus says, "I am the way and the truth and the life, no one comes to the Father except through me." The interviewee's comment is totally contrary to God's word. He says it al depends on how the verse "is heard". If he is correct in saying that there are "many paths" then he is calling Jesus a liar. The interviewee goes on to say, "There's the
