# Who is Jesus?

"Go therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son, and the Holy Spirit..." Matthew 28:19

For the last several weeks I have been developing a relationship with an Ismali Muslim man that works at Valley View Mall. We have a good dialog going. Isaiah 1:18 says, "Come now, let us reason together, says the LORD. Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red as crimson, they shall be like wool." I think this is a prophecy about Jesus washing away our sin. Something else that comes from this verse is that God shows us to use logic and reason. So I said to my Muslim friend (about heaven), "either you are right, I am right or we are both wrong." He agreed. So I said, "if only one of us is right, shouldn't we figure out which belief is correct?" Again, he agreed. I gave him a booklet called "Why Christianity" and he gave me some information on his religion including a web site and a few keywords to search on the internet. I looked those up and come to the conclusion that the main difference is in deciding who is Jesus? According to several Islamic sites and resources he was created from the dust, was just a prophet and was taken up to heaven by God the Father prior to the crucifixion. According to God, Jesus is His son (Matthew 3:17, 17:5). According to

Jesus, he and the Father are one (John 17:21) and he is the only way to God the Father (John 14:6). If the Quorn is right, then Jesus is a liar. If Jesus is right, then Muhammad is a liar and all Islamic people are headed straight for hell. The Bible is historically and scientifically accurate. Therefore we know Jesus is who he said he is! I picked up a copy of "The Case for Christ" on DVD and previewed it. Then on Monday I took it to the mall and loaned it to my friend. He said he would watch it and then loan it to one of his co-workers to watch it also. Please pray that when they see the evidence that they will choose to follow Jesus!

Witnessing at Kaboom Town last night in Addison, we had a number of excellent conversations about the Gospel. We were handing out a tract that says "Everyone Goes to Heaven" on the front. Inside the tract is a description of how Jesus will judge every man (as if they come to heaven for this) and then determine if they enter (or stay in) heaven or are cast into hell for eternity.
