What If?

"Go therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son, and the Holy Spirit..." Matthew 28:19

I have noticed something recently. A lot of people are on their way to hell and they don't even seem to care. Jesus tells us to enter through the narrow gate. He says that many will enter through the wide gate that leads to destruction and only few will enter through the narrow gate that leads to righteousness. If you look at what a Hindu, Muslim, Buddhist and Christian each believe, they can not all be right. Either one is right and the others are all wrong. Or, none is right. Now you may be saying that I am trying to be too logical about this but the Prophet Isaiah says that the Lord says that "we should reason together". So when I appeal to the persons intellect I can help them see that four things that are contrary can not all be true. They will tend to agree. As a Christian, we have scientific evidence, historical evidence, and prophetic evidence to support the Bible. In other words, we can prove that the Bible is true. Thus, Jesus's words are true and He then is the only way to salvation. Applying logic, the others are all false. We don't then have to prove them to be false. Just like if I know that George Bush is President of the United States and I can prove it by showing the election results, then I don't have to

go and prove the other 8 Billion people on the planet are not the president. They can not be, because there is only one President. However, what I like to do is ask people of other faiths what evidence they have to believe what they believe. Ask a Muslim what evidence there is that the Quron is true. Or ask a mormon what evidence there is that the golden plates exist. They are stumped because no evidence exists! People often say that believing in God is blind faith. Actually, I think the converse is true when you examine the evidence.

So the question now arises. "If what you believe about eternity to not true, would you want to know about it?" So while shopping at Sam's I started an informal survey asking people this one question. I was amazed as person after person told me "NO!" Now several of these people told me they were Christians and that they knew they were not wrong. However, it still amazes me that someone could be wrong about where they will spend eternity and not even want to consider the facts and evidence.
