We explained that we have to all understand our predicament in relation to God's law in order for their to be any good news. Stanley had a medical bracelet on his arm. We explained that he would only wear that having known and agreed that he needed it. He agreed. We finally got them to understand that there is "none that is good". We were then able to share the Gospel with them. Stanley's face absolutely beamed when he heard the good news! Bernice was still a bit skeptical. They both took Gospels of John and said
