A new movie opened on Friday by comedian Bill Maher called Religious. In this movie Mr. Maher criticizes all world religions. No, I have not seen this movie and I am not suggesting that you should go see it. However, it raises something interesting to discuss. When we are out witnessing and turn the discussion to spiritual things people will often ask "is this about religion?" To this we answer no! Why? Because Christianity, unlike all other religions is about a personal relationship with God rather than doing something to earn our way to God. When all other religions say "do", Christianity says "done!" We talk to people every day who talk about being good enough to earn their way to God. They create rules to follow to try to show how good they are. Jews think they can be good enough to earn favor with God. Muslims believe that if they are good, Mohammed will strike a deal with God for their forgiveness. Hindu's believe that if they are good, they will reincarnate to a better life. The list goes on. Yet when we show them God's commandments and that they have already broken them and that they already stand condemned before God, their natural conclusion is that they must work harder. Try that in

a court of law. Admit to murder, rape or even copying a few DVDs. Then expect to just "do" some good things and have the judge release you. He won't. A good judge must punish sin. Religion is man trying to earn favor with God. It makes me wonder, where did religion come from? I believe that Genesis 3:2-3 gives us the answer, 'The woman said to the serpent, "We may eat fruit from the trees in the garden, but God did say, 'You must not eat fruit from the tree that is in the middle of the garden, and you must not touch it, or you will die.' " God had told Adam not to eat of the fruit. He did

not say it could not be touched. Adam and Eve had added a rule to God's rule. It is important to note that through this event, comes the first promise of Jesus. Genesis 3:15 states (God speaking to satan), 'And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; he will crush your head, and you will strike his heel.' ' That promise is that their descendant will crush satan! That promise is fulfilled on the cross. John 19:30 says, 'When he had received the drink, Jesus said, "It is finished." With that, he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.' Jesus has done it, there is nothing left for us to do to earn our salvation.
