One of the resources the ministry has is 50 episodes of Way of the Master radio in mp3 format called Addicted! I've been listening to these and have nearly gotten all 50 listened too. The other night I was listening to one episode while I was driving home from work. The show was an interview with Mark Cahill, who also does evangelism ministry. Mark was mentioning that Ray Comfort, founder of the Way of the Master ministry, always stops someplace to witness on his way home. So the next day, I decided to try this. Instead of stopping on my way home, I stopped on the way to work. Near my office is a DART Park & Ride station. I stopped there on my way to the office. I grabbed a handful of tracts and walked around by the people waiting for the bus. In less than 15 minutes I was able to hand out a dozen tracts, share the Gospel three times (Nick, Erwardo, and Ricardo) and pray with three believers! Things were a bit fast paced because when the bus comes, you have to be able to wrap up the conversation so they can leave! This went so well, that I decided to go back again the next day. I had similar results with an in depth conversation about the Gospel with a Hindu named Kuram. I
