It's not about the Chips!

"Go therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son, and the Holy Spirit..." Matthew 28:19

Last Sunday, Tom, Eric and I headed out to Texas Stadium during the Cowboys-49ers game. After the game we greeted the fans as they were leaving. We handed out 1200 Gospel Tracts! Please pray that these seeds will take root and people will be saved. A friend once told me that he looked forward to the day that he was out witnessing and someone witnessed to him. This happened to my son Eric while we were at this event. Eric handed a man a tract. The man, who was wearing a voice of the martyrs t-shirt, in return handed Eric an IQ Test business card tract from Living Waters! That was really cool! And very memorable for Eric! On Thanksgiving, Tom and I headed back to Texas Stadium. The plan was to hand out tracts before the game between the Cowboys and the Seahawks. God had some other plans for us. When we got there is was about 15 minutes before kick off. Normally at that time there are still people streaming into the stadium. But on this day, there was almost no one around. We meet a man named Thomas and were able to have a long conversation with him about

God, heaven, hell, eternity and the after life. He said his uncle is a preacher and tries to talk to him about Jesus whenever he can. But, Thomas has always been resistant and uninterested. We went through the Gospel presentation. I explained to him that sin separates us from God and that the only remedy is to repent of sin and trust Jesus the savior. He agreed

to think about it and then said he needed to get to the game.

As we walked away from talking with him, Tom mentioned that he did not think we would hand out as many tracts as we did last time. We discussed how that is okay. This ministry is not about the number of tracts distributed or the number of "decisions for Christ" that we hear. It is only about doing faithfully what God has called us to do - share his word. We use some statistics like how many tracts we hand out and how many people we share one on one with just as benchmarks to keep doing what we are doing.

Tom and I walked on towards the stadium where we had a conversation with Marcus who freely admitted that he would go to hell. He said he needed to get saved. Yet he was holding back. I told him that I knew why he would not give his life to Christ. He looked baffled. I told him that the Bible says why any person will not give their life to Jesus. I asked him if he was familiar with John 3:16? He said yes. So we turned there in a Gospel of John that I had with me. Starting from that verse I read on through verse 19 which states, "This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but men loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil." I explained to him that by Jesus' own words that he was choosing sin over a relationship with Jesus and hence choosing sin over being saved. We left him with the Gospel of John and a tract. We then meet Darrell, a ticket scalper, and had a similar conversation with him. While sharing the Gospel, he suddenly walked off following some people that were trying to buy tickets. We then went over to the parking lot of the stadium and had several more conversations with people that we did not get their names

After these conversations we decided to head home. We were about two miles from my house when Mande called me to ask if I had already passed Wal-Mart. I said yes. And she was like "oh, well". I asked what she needed and she said "Tortilla Chips". I said that we were right near WalGreens and Thom Thumb and surely one of them would be open and have some. So we pulled into WalGreens. Sure enough we found some tortilla chips. I went and checked out and then went and waited for Tom outside of the store. Tom was looking for an employee to ask a question. I handed out a couple of tracts to people as they came into the store. While I was waiting, a woman came up to the store singing a Christmas carol in a very pitiful sounding voice. I asked if she was okay. She said she was down and that singing Christmas songs helped to cheer her up. So I asked her what had her so down. She told me that in the past five years both of her parents had passed away and thinking about past holidays was hard. Somehow the Holy Spirit let me ask this next question because if the answer had been no, I'd have been in a very awkward position. I asked her, "Did your parents know Jesus?" She said, "Oh, yes" and she started to smile. And so I followed up with, "do you know Him?" She said yes again. I told her that because of that alone she could be Thankful because one day they will all be together again in heaven. She agreed. Joy just completely filled her face. Somewhere in this conversation, Tom joined me. She went on to tell us that her husband, of 31 years, had also died recently. She told us that she was going to some friends house on Thanksgiving and had actually driven out of her way to get to this WalGreens to get them a newspaper so they could look at the sales ads. We explained that we were only there to buy chips because my wife had called a few minutes earlier. It was then that she said, "It's not about the Chips. God sent you here to minister to me." We agreed. We prayed with her for encouragement and strength. And gave her a copy of Max Lucado's book 3:16 to encourage her in her walk with Jesus. We never know who will be encouraged or saved just by saying hello or handing out a tract.

It was really amazing how the whole day we thought we were going to hand out 1000 tracts at Texas Stadium. Instead we got to have a number of in depth conversations and be a great encouragement to Jackie. It's not about the number of tracts we hand out. And it's not about the Chips!
