

Win, Win!

"Go therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son, and the Holy Spirit..." Matthew 28:19

In baseball a batter is "successful" if he can get a hit 30% of the time. He is considered exceptional if he can hit the ball 40% of the time. In basketball, a shooter is consider successful if he can make 50% of his shots or 30% of his three pointers! In the book One Thing You Can't Do in Heaven, Mark Cahill describes the success percentages of witnessing. He first describes that when we witness to someone there are three outcomes: the person accepts Christ (win), a seed is planted (win) or they reject Christ (lose). This means in any given encounter we have a 66% chance of winning. Pretty good considering the percentages that sports measures their success with! However, Mark goes on to point out that 1 Peter 4:14 says, "If ye be reproached for the name of Christ, happy are ye; for the spirit of glory and of God resteth upon you: On their part he is evil spoken of, but on your part he is glorified." thus, even when rejected, we win and hence any witnessing opportunity is a win, win, win situation.

Isaiah 55:11 tells us, "so is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but

In the past year we have witnessed at a number of sporting events. This includes Dallas Cowboys games, Dallas Stars games, Frisco Rough Riders games, FC Dallas soccer games, North Texas Football games, Univeristy of Oklahoma football games as well as some others. When we witness after a game it is very intersting to notice that the mood of the people leaving the stadium is directly related to the result of the game. I figure 90-95% of the people are cheering for the home team. The other 5-10% are cheering for the visitor. Given that the fans have no barring on the outcome of the game means that most people will leave the game either happy or sad based on an outcome that they have nothing to do with. Compare this with going to the game to witness about Jesus Christ. We already know from the previous text that any witnessing opportunity is a win, win, win situation. Going to a sporting event is a win - win situation. Regardless of which team wins the game, we win because we have the joy of sharing Christ with others!

Acknowledge Jesus!

"Whoever acknowledges me before men, I will also acknowledge him before my Father in heaven. But whoever disowns me before men, I will disown him before my Father in heaven." (Matthew 10:32-33)
